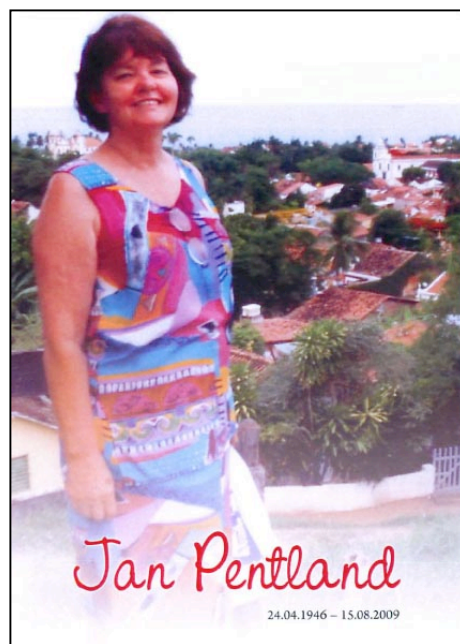

ABOUT THE JAN PENTLAND PRIZE

FCA invites nominations for the 2017 Jan Pentland Prize.

The Prize honours the life and work of a former Chair of Financial Counselling Australia and campaigner for social justice, Jan Pentland. The Prize is for the amount of \$1,000.

The Prize recognises the work of an **individual, group or organisation** in the community sector, focussing on the financial and/or consumer rights of disadvantaged people in Australia. This includes work in the areas of financial counselling, financial inclusion, and consumer credit law.

While the achievement may relate to assisting individuals, or working for social change, a particular focus is the effective integration of casework with campaigning for broader change.

Nominations could focus on one specific activity or achievement, or on a contribution over an extended period, and should specifically address at least one of the following criteria:

- **Outstanding achievement in financial counselling and/or consumer advocacy ;**
- **Achievement in undertaking law reform, campaign work, community development, and/or community education.**

The winner of the Jan Pentland Prize will be announced at the Jan Pentland Foundation dinner on Tuesday 16th May 2017.

The dinner is being held the Royal Pines Resort on the Gold Coast, coinciding with the FCA Conference. The link to register for the dinner is on the FCA conference website – www.fcaconference.com.au

The Jan Pentland Prize is made possible through the generosity of Jan's partner, David Morawetz. The winner will be selected by a committee comprised of an independent chair, the chair of FCA (Carmel Franklin) and a representative of the sector.
